The nine snowmobile clubs that make up the Oneida County Snowmobile Council were contacted this morning by the Forestry Department to evaluate whether or not the new snowfall was enough to open Oneida County trails.

Based on the lack of significant new snow, two-thirds of the clubs voted to keep the trails closed at this time.

Once we receive another snowfall, the OCSC will again reevaluate the trails. Unfortunately, the long range forecast doesn't look very encouraging for the next week or so.
